B. Messier

- 1. Cemeteries are orderly, structured, with few messes or surprises...but there's no life there
- 2. Nurseries are messy but full of life
- **C. Squad:** we are to be a smaller unit of 6-12 Believers consistently gathered together.

D. Prayer for Present Leaders:

1. When Spirit of God moves people volunteer freely; pray for new interns to be raised up.

III. UP: Seeking God

- 4Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me. 5I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing. John 15:4-5
- **A. Kernel Thought:** Our connection with YHWH is our first and primary assignment. If we love God well, we will be able to love others much more effectively.

B. Other Helps

- 1. *This Takes Faith* to set it as a priority
- 2. <u>There's Bound to Come Some Trouble</u>: God wants to use our trouble for good. We live in a broken world with broken people. What will you do with your trouble?
- 3. Prayer (& Fasting): In this season of increasing the times that we are meeting in the home, it is more important than ever to be asking God for His help, wisdom, protection, and blessing.
- 4. <u>Abiding in Yeshua's Love</u>: We have a greater ability to love God more deeply if we have a greater revelation of His love for us

Yeshua: "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love." John 15:9

Yeshua: "And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare *it*, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them." John 17:26

- 5. This Takes Time
- To break through this double barrier—of distractions from without and self consciousness within—might take me anything from 5 minutes to half an hour. But once I had succeeded in pressing through the barrier, it was as though a fountain opened up inside me. Prayer began to flow forth from some source within me, deeper than my conscious mind. - 6. God Promises to Reward Us

But you, when you pray, go into your inner room, close your door and pray to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees *what is done* in secret will reward you. Matthew 6:7

C. Individually

- 1. Set Apart Times: These are primary times where with schedule larger chunks of time to spend with God.
- 2. On the Run: These are supplemental 10-20 second connecting prayers with Yeshua all throughout the day.
- **D. With Others:** There are multiple times throughout the week we are able to pray with others. There are also opportunities with the Upper Room prayer times to connect with God together with others.
- 1. In the Lifeboats, we have opportunity to pray and seek God together.
