# **Loving Our Neighbor**

39The second is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' 40On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets." Matthew 22:39-40

# I. INTRODUCTION

- **A. Teaching Trajectory:** Weightier commandments getting more focus; loving God, loving others, walking in His upside-down kingdom
- **B.** Application is Important: Familiarity with the commandments doesn't mean we are actually applying them

# II. FIRST COMMANDMENT IS PRIMARY

- A. If we try to put the second commandment first we will experience burn out
- B. If we put the first commandment first we will naturally love others

# III. THE SECOND COMMANDMENT

- **A. Definition:** "For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Galatians 5:14 (ESV)
- B. Who is our Neighbor?
  - 1. Anyone around us in need (Luke 10:25-37)
  - 2. Our Enemies
  - "But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven" Matthew 5:44 (ESV)
    - a. to love our enemies, we have to have a present tense living relational connection with Yeshua and we have to walk in active forgiveness.
  - 3. Fellow Believers
  - "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." John 13:34-35 (ESV)
- B. Repentance & Humility: We are deficient in this. Lord forgive us
  - 1. Prayer: "Yeshua, help us to see people as You see them"


# C. Progression of Love

- 1. <u>Family</u>: Those in our immediate household; often these are the ones that are most difficult to love in a consistent and sacrificial way. We can't hide with those who see us with this proximity.
  - a. success: having those who are closest to you respect you the most
  - b. Abraham Lincoln: "I care not for a man's religion whose dog and cat are not the better for it."
- 2. <u>Household of Faith</u>: we are connected into a spiritual family. Just as in a regular family, we don't pick our spiritual sisters and brothers. We are required to love them deeply
  - a. The Believer's love & unity will be the sign to the world that we are His disciples and will provide proof that the Father sent Yeshua (John 13:35 & John 17:20-23)
    - i. This will happen in the greatest measure before the end of the age
  - b. Discipleship: all active and involved
- 3. <u>The Lost</u>: the greatest expression of love towards them is to share the gospel
- For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost." Luke 19:10
  - a. First to the Jew, then to the Greek (Romans 1:16)
- **D. Sharing with Others:** are you ready to share your testimony and the Gospel? How often do you share parts of your story? \_\_\_ and His story? \_\_\_ How often do you pray for the sick and oppressed? \_\_\_ Are there any needed changes?

- **3. Prayer List:** who are two people in your sphere who don't know the Lord? \_\_\_\_\_ How often do you pray for them?
- **4. Practice** sharing shema statements, bridge statements, your testimony, the Gospel, and offering to pray for people
- E. God will pour out His Spirit: Are we ready?
  - 1. Lifeboats all over the city: starting new ones everywhere so new Believers have a place to grow
    - a. Commands of Christ: New groups can go over the basics to help disciple new Believers
  - 2. Resource the younger Believers we want them to go far past us

    - a. When Gospel Advances: Persecution will happen when the gospel advances. But don't get persecuted for stupid tactics; get persecuted for obedience. David Watson's people memorize this line and say it when they are being martyred: You do not take my life from me. I voluntarily give it to you so that one day you can know Jesus as your savior.
