felt I had a biblical responsibility to share with anyone who asked me about my spiritual beliefs. In our conversation I discovered that my boss was fine with that. I was grateful for this conversation but also realized that it was not up to my boss to give me "permission" to respectfully share my faith. God had asked me to always be ready to share that with others.

Using this verse as a prototype, we are each required to be ready to share our faith story. Over the months ahead, we are planning to have at least two people from the Lighthouse share each month on Sabbath their stories of faith. We will plan to video these stories and then have a "bouquet" of our stories that will be available on the Lighthouse website so that others can watch us share our foundational stories of Yeshua's work in our lives.
