
Today is the second passover reminding us of God's desire to be in covenant with us

9Then YHWH spoke to Moses, saying, 10"Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, 'If any one of you or of your generations becomes unclean because of a dead person, or is on a distant journey, he may, however, observe the Passover to YHWH. 11In the second month on the fourteenth day at twilight, they shall observe it; they shall eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs. 12They shall leave none of it until morning, nor break a bone of it; according to all the statute of the Passover they shall observe it. Numbers 9:9-12

Second Passover & New Beginnings

Tonight at sundown the second Passover started. Passover is the only biblical festival that there is an opportunity to do a re-do if someone misses the first one. I think the main reason for this is that the Passover foundationally punctuates the need for each person to appropriate the blood of the Lamb of

God on the doorposts of their heart. If a person misses this foundational reality, they miss everything. God wants to give everyone ample opportunity to receive His covenantal mark (see Exodus 13:9-10). Tonight we have a Lighthouse group of ~two dozen people who will be renewing their covenant with YHWH in a second Passover covenant meal.

I believe this is a season marking second chances and new beginnings. God the Father is running towards those who are turning back towards Him, and He wants us also running towards those who are returning. Tomorrow we will be entering a new season as we shift out of the facility that we've been meeting in for nearly 15 years. We'll be praying for and blessing new house church leaders as well as entering into a 3 week time of fasting and praying for Israel.
