We are invited to join God in what we see that He's already doing



So Yeshua explained, "I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself. He does only what he sees the Father doing. Whatever the Father does, the Son also does. John 5:19

## Joining what God's Doing

Over thirty years ago, I remember being positively impacted by Henry Blackaby's *Experiencing God* 12-week discipleship curriculum. The main takeaway was that Yeshua didn't operate from His own initiative but that He only did what He saw His Father doing (found in the John 5:19 verse above). The supplemental point was that we don't need to launch out with something brand new, but we should just look to see where God is already moving around us and then join with Him. At times I get restless and antsy to do more than what I'm doing. In those times the concepts above are calibrating for me. I just need to ask God to help me see where He is already moving and then ask Him to show me how I can engage in becoming involved and helpful in that area.

I was in a meeting this week where another brother mentioned this concept, and I immediately was brought back thirty plus years. But, better than just recalling this principle, I was able to have confidence to join in with a greater practical involvement where I saw that God was moving. I didn't need to have a heavenly word or personal invitation. As I took the steps towards greater engagement I felt God's confirming peace that I had done the right thing.

What about you? Where is God already moving around you? You can ask Him how to be a part of joining what He's already doing. And if you're not aware of an area He's already moving, then just ask Him to show You what He's doing so that you can join Him in His kingdom work.

Father we thank You that You are already involved in kingdom activities all around us. Give us eyes to see the areas that You are already at work that we can join in. Give us Your wisdom for the areas that You would want us to help out with and clarity as to how best to do that.
